

KENT PRESBYTERY EXECUTIVE COMMISSION AUG. 22, 2007 2007/2008-13

The Summer Commission established by the Executive of Kent Presbytery on June 21, 2007, as noted on page 2007/2008-11, met on Wednesday August 22, 2007 at 10:00 AM at the Cedar Springs manse, 8647 Talbot Trail, Cedar Springs. A quorum was present throughout the meeting.

ATTENDANCE: Cathy Collins-Barker, Ed Nicol, Larry Atkinson, and Bonnie Harvey.

REGRETS: Doug Cameron, who had declared a conflict of interest.

Chairperson Cathy Collins-Barker opened the meeting with prayer. The meeting was called to deal with a request from the Trustees of the Chalmers United Church to complete the sale of the properties noted on page 2006/2007-92 of the minutes of Kent Presbytery.

Two motions were presented.

1. Moved by Larry Atkinson and seconded by Bonnie Harvey that Kent Presbytery give permission to the Trustees of Chalmers United Church to sell the manse located as 00742-0039 (R) part of the northwest half of the northeast quarter of Lot 9, Con. 6. geographic Township of Chatham., for the sum of \$95,000.00, and the vacant lot located as follows, 00742-038 (R) part of the northwest half of Lot 9 Con. 6, geographic Township of Chatham for the sum of \$5,000.00.
2. Moved by Larry Atkinson and seconded by Ed Nicol that the lands on which the present church stands, located at 00742-042 one square half acre off the northwest corner of Lot 10, Con 6, geographic Township of Chatham, be turned back to the farm from which it was originally granted. This farm is now owned by Mr. Dan Blonde.

Both motions were approved.
